

## The Training Package

To receive this extensive resource pack, schools need to attend training **all the modules.** Following recommendations from the Centre for Evaluation and Monitoring, and the Teacher Development Trust, effective training should be intense and sustained, the expectation is that teachers in primary schools will have at least 10 hours of CPD on *Understanding Christianity*. There will be gaps between encounters when schools will try out the approach, returning to explore further.

Understanding Christianity gives in-depth support to the Christianity sections of the <u>new Cornwall RE syllabus</u>.

It aims to develop pupils' understanding of key concepts in Christianity, as a contribution to their understanding of the world and their own experience within it. This 3-session course will give teachers full access to this outstanding resource and nationally recognised system of learning in RE.

Session 1 - Tuesday 2nd February Modules 1 and 2 (Introduction and Teaching & Learning)

Sessions 2 - Tuesday 23rd March Modules 3 and 4 (The Big Story of the Bible and Planning great Teaching & Learning)

Session 3 - Wednesday 21st April Modules 5,6 and 7 (Purpose & Impact, Digging Deeper, Curriculum Design)

• Each session will include setting teachers a 'gap task', trialling an aspect of the resource in school.

• Feedback and discussion on these 'gap tasks' will be included in each session, so that teachers can share ideas and learn from each other's experiences.
