

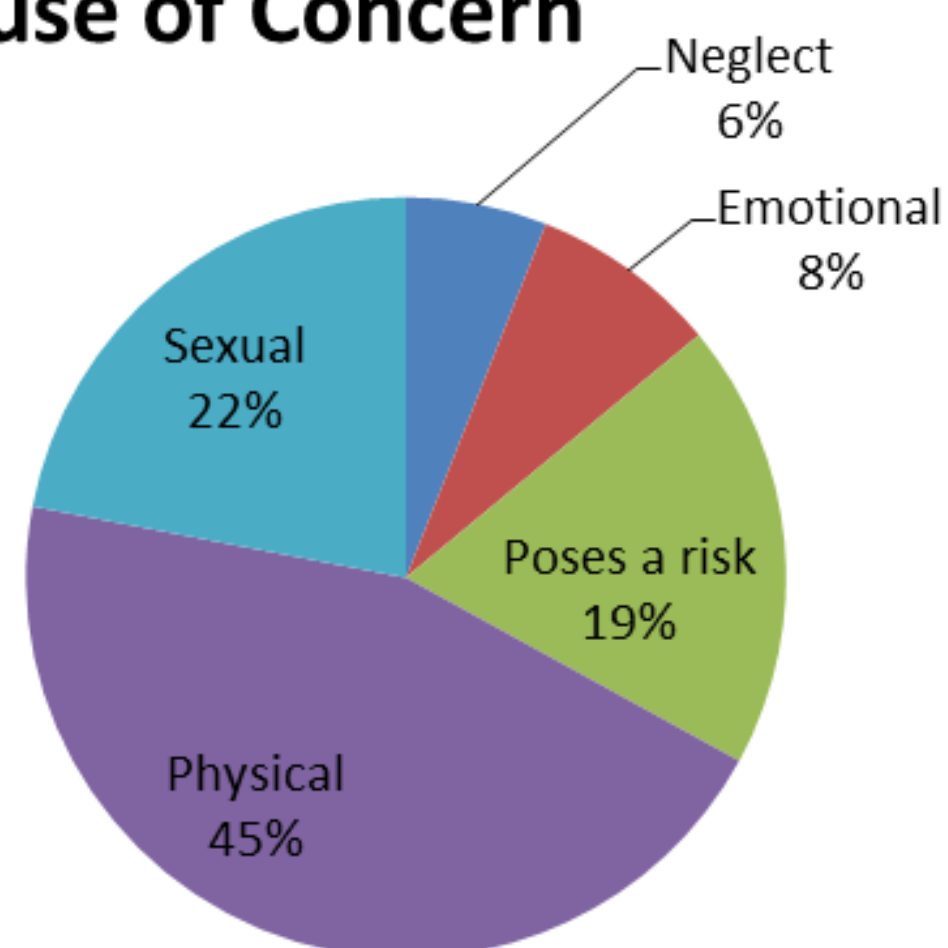

“Anyone can contact the LADO if they are worried an adult who works/ volunteers with children is a risk”

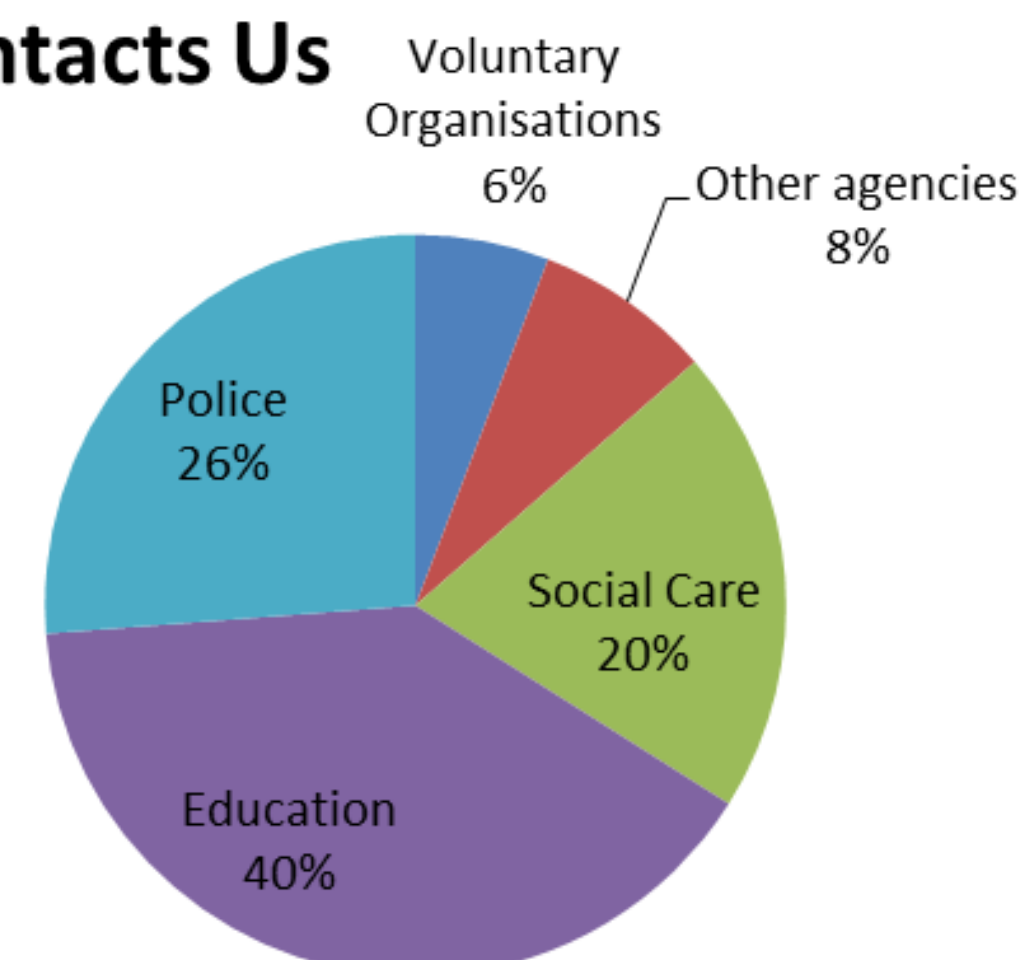
“Feedback from workshops—100% improved outcomes for children”
