What is Think BIG?

Think BIG is a 'Dragon's Den' style competition aimed at primary and secondary school councils in Cornwall. Students on the school council will generate ideas on how £500 can be spent to improve something within a school. It promotes entrepreneurship, creative thinking, presentation skills and team work.

- 3 The shortlist will be announced to everyone who has entered on Wednesday 4th March 2020
- 4 If your idea is shortlisted, you will be invited to present it to a panel of judges (10 minutes presentation followed by Q&A) at BF Adventure, Halvasso, Longdowns, Penryn, TR10 9BX, on Thursday 26th March 2020. Two schools will be awarded £500 to spend on their chosen project.

What should our idea focus on?

Something important to your school! The idea should be of benefit to the whole school community and solve an existing problem. It should be implemented by the end of July 2020.

What format can the presentation be?

If shortlisted, your pitch should be no more than 10 minutes long and can be in the format of your choice.
