
Child or adult with:

High temperature

New continuous cough

Loss of taste or smell (Anosmia)

Also, be aware of: Fatigue; sore throat; nausea/vomiting/diarrhoea; headache.



- 2. Arrange a test ASAP (NHS 119)
- **3.** Household continue to isolate until test result known
- School/setting carry on as normal unless positive result received
