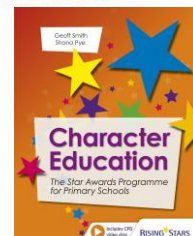




An Introduction to Virtues in Education

What is 'Character Education and Virtues in Education' (Vine)?

- VINE empowers teachers to support the growth and understanding of key virtues & character qualities. This enables children to develop emotional intelligence and self belief
- To make detached conscious decisions to get the right outcome in any situation, whether it be academic or social.

How does it Work?

- Use language to build trust and increase hope, engagement and wellbeing
- Recognise teachable moments to develop authentic self esteem and resilience
- Utilize virtues based boundaries promoting personal responsibility, integrity and self-discipline
- Creating a culture of mutual respect and appreciation

Why use VINE in your School?

- The school community realise that in order to achieve each child's potential, building a strong resilient character is equally as important as academic achievement.

In our ever-changing world, we want our children and young people to be equipped with the understanding and belief that they can deal with any situation by making use of their own innate resources.
