



Running a School

A series of tailor made training days designed to further develop leadership and management skills

Introduction:

These practical training days are intended for those aspiring to 'Run a School'; those about to take up a leadership role in a school and those currently engaged in the business of 'Running a School'. The content is suitable for the primary or secondary phase.

Each full day workshop moves from a theoretical perspective, through a consideration of issues to practical solutions.
