- → **Please notify us** via phnotifications@cornwall.gov.uk using the Confirmed Case Report. We can also provide you with advice and support.
- → You only need to call PHE on 0300 303 8162 if you are advised to do so by the DfE or someone has been admitted to hospital.

5+ confirmed cases in the same group over 14 days
