Update September 2020

2020 has struck again and we've gone virtual, however... we will still be giving you an education extravaganza not to be missed! What sessions are still running?

Almost all of the content originally planned will still be available!

There is only one speaker who can't join us online. All sessions are listed at <u>https://caphedenconference2020.sched.com/</u>. The schedule has been updated to reflect the new virtual format.

Have timings changed?

Yes, a little bit. We have reduced the session length to an hour, rather than 90 minutes, as we think that works better online. There are now 4 different timeslots running on Thursday and 3 on Friday. We have planned the keynotes and workshops so that the majority can still attend those sessions you are already signed up for without any clashes. You may also be able to attend additional sessions now.

How do I see my schedule now?

Go to <u>https://caphedenconference2020.sched.com/</u> and log-in. You will then see your personal schedule, in some cases there will have been adjustments due to the new online timings. If you want to make any changes, you can do that by ticking/unticking the box next to the session titles to add to or remove from your schedule.

How can we view the content on the day?

Sessions will be streamed through Zoom on the day. Links to the video streams will be added to the session information at <u>https://caphedenconference2020.sched.com/</u>. Further details about accessing content will be sent out nearer to the event time – we've found a great local firm to help us make sure the event runs smoothly.

Can we watch sessions together as a staff group?

Yes. You will just need one person to access the video stream and show that on a large screen. The only thing to consider will be nominating someone to submit questions on behalf of the group.

Will the sessions be interactive?

Yes. There will be Q&A for all sessions. All the presenters are becoming very polished at online delivery in this COVID world.

Which is the session no longer running?

Sadly, the Vocabulary Ninja has cancelled his session with us. He did provide some free material for attendees – <u>The Vocabulary Ninja Approach</u>. Dandelion Learning are also offering a session on Successfully Teaching Vocabulary. We have signed up all those registered for the Vocabulary Ninja session up to the Dandelion Learning Session for now – you can change this in your schedule if that doesn't suit you.

What about the outdoor learning sessions?

We have had to reduce these slightly as we can't physically go outdoors! However, the Eden Project Schools team and the team behind the National Curriculum Outdoors books are able to still offer their sessions. If you were booked into one of the other outdoor sessions planned, you will need to select another session.

A note on Laughter Yoga...

Katie White has adapted her content brilliantly to online delivery. She works with smaller groups online so we are now offering two sessions on the Thursday afternoon.
