## Save Money and Energy!

When considering how to reduce our impact on the environment less is usually more. The green charter adopted by most schools across Cornwall sets out the aim to **reduce energy** by 10 %.

### 4 Simple Steps to Save Energy:

- 1. Take a baseline reading. Your site manager should have access to this data, if not contact the energy provider.

- 3. It is a good idea to provide training and information to school staff this often most powerful with student input. Remember to keep everyone informed of your progress!
- 4. Take your final readings after two weeks
