## Suspected case

For queries and advice regarding suspected cases you can:

#### 1 confirmed case

- $\rightarrow$  Call the DfE if you need advice on 0800 046 8687.
- → **Please notify us** via <a href="mailto:phinotifications@cornwall.gov.uk">phinotifications@cornwall.gov.uk</a> using the Confirmed Case Report. We can also provide you with advice and support.
- → You only need to call PHE on 0300 303 8162 if you are advised to do so by the DfE.

## 2+ confirmed cases in the same group

- $\rightarrow$  Call the DfE if you need advice on 0800 046 8687.
- → Please notify us via <a href="mailto:phnotifications@cornwall.gov.uk">phnotifications@cornwall.gov.uk</a> using the Confirmed Case Report. We can also provide you with advice and support.
- → Contact PHE on 0300 303 8162 if:
- You have had more than 5 cases in 14 days
- You have taken all required action and numbers are still increasing
- You think you may need to close due to the numbers affected
- Someone has been admitted to hospital
- o You are receiving significant media interest
