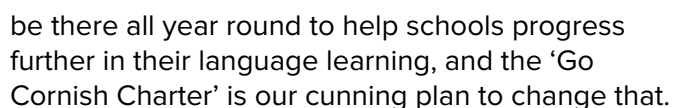

At different points in the year, we worked alongside ‘cluster groups’ of schools with our activities culminating in Cornish language family trails such as ‘Nadelik Lyskerrys’ (Liskeard Christmas) and ‘Para Pennsans’ (Penzance Crew).
