This 3 year part-time MA: Values-led Leadership course offered by The Learning Institute in partnership with Newman University has a rich diversity of modules. This enables MA students to link their research and developing skills to their professional aspirations. Students research questions that are important to them to generate values-based explanations of their educational influence in their own learning, the learning of others, and the learning of social formations.

Our MA is a flexible course, combining taught modules and Living Educational Theory research (Whitehead, 2017). Living Educational Theory is a methodology which starts with the student and their practice, values and the educational influences they have.

Our MA is designed for those who work in any field of education or training, and whose aim is to develop and improve their leadership skills, enhance their professional profile and engage in rigorous research and high level enquiry.

The modules support professional development through investigation of current educational issues in the context of values-led leadership. The MA can develop leadership of teaching and learning, administrative lead or senior leaders. Research based values-led practice through a Living Educational Theory methodology is at the heart of our MA.

Each of the five modules provides academic rigour, excellent supervision and high quality resources and support.

MA MODULES

YEAR 1

Research Design (30 credits)
Professional Enquiry (30 Credits)

YEAR 2

Values-led Leadership (30 credits)
Leading Change (30 credits)

YEAR 3

Dissertation (60 credits)

The MA and The Learning Institute's wider leadership courses continue the development of students' professional mastery underpinned by values-led leadership.
