Our new campaign aims to educate people about what constitutes a forced marriage and to further highlight that it is illegal.

We want to reduce the number of people forced into marriages against their will in the UK by challenging, empowering, and inspiring practising communities to change the way they perceive forced marriage and to take preventative action against this abhorrent practice.

The campaign will be disseminated across a variety of channels including paid media, partner networks and community outreach activity.
