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# THINK BIG ENTRY GUIDELINES

## What is Think BIG?

Think BIG is a 'Dragon's Den' style competition aimed at primary and secondary school councils in Cornwall. Students on the school council will generate ideas on how £500 can be spent to improve something within a school. It promotes entrepreneurship, creative thinking, presentation skills and team work.

## Think BIG entry: what does your school council need to do to enter?

1. Register by emailing Katie Chandler by Friday 25 January 2019 - [katie@caph.org.uk](mailto:katie@caph.org.uk)
2. Think how to improve something in your school using £500. Present the idea as an A4 poster. Send this poster to Katie Chandler at CAPH by Friday 1 March 2019.

3. The shortlist will be announced to everyone who has entered on Friday 8 March 2019.
4. If your idea is shortlisted, you will be invited to present it to a panel of judges (10 minutes presentation followed by Q&A) on Tuesday 2 April 2019 at Cornwall's largest creative hub, Krowji, Redruth. Both the primary and secondary school winners will be awarded £500 each.

## What should your idea focus on?

Your idea should be of benefit to the whole school community and solve an existing problem. It should be implemented by the end of July 2019.

## What format can the presentation be?

If shortlisted, your pitch should be no more than 10 minutes long and can be in the format of your choice.

## What is the prize?

Following the presentations, the judges will select two ideas to receive £500 each. This money has been provided by Michelmores as part of their partnership with CAPH and must be put towards

implementing the ideas. There will be publicity in the summer term when the project is completed.

## What are the deadlines?

- **Registration: Friday 25 January 2019**
- **Entry: Friday 1 March 2019**
- **Shortlist announced: Friday 8 March 2019**
- **Pitch presentations and winners announced: Tuesday 2 April 2019**
