- COVID-19 impact on attendance data and reporting.
- Children Missing Out on Education (CMOE) for reintegration – when to use and application of the local framework for effective ongoing monitoring and evaluation.
- Off-Rolling and EHE – evidencing support for pupils at risk of opting for EHE.
- In-year Admissions – developing good practice.

The sessions will be interactive to allow delegates the opportunity to ask questions about the subjects discussed with regards to their own individual provision. This means each session has a maximum of 10 spaces available.
